Frequently asked Questions at City Hall

Building a fence? Please make sure you contact City Hall for a permit. Although there is no fee to build a fence, the city does have codes that need to be followed and they require approval.

Building a storage shed? Sheds under 200sq feet do not require a permit. If you are building anything bigger you must get a structural permit from the city and follow city codes.

Boats & Campers? Are not allowed to be parked on the streets in the front of your home for more that 72 hours. This allows time for loading/unloading and cleaning only. Camping/Living in RV's or Campers on your property is NOT allowed.

Sidewalk Maintenance? It is the property owners responsibility to maintain the sidewalk in the front or side of their homes or business. This means clear of debris, moss and repairs to prevent residents from injuring themselves.

Dog Reminder

It is the responsibility of the pet owner to clean up after your dog when you are out and about.
Mutt Mitts are available in the parks.

Trash Cans

As a courtesy to your neighbors, be sure to remove your trash and recycling cans from the curb after pick-up day. It is City policy to keep the streets and sidewalks clear. Trash cans should be kept on the side of your home.

Weed Control

As stipulated in City Ordinance #709; tall grass and weeds are not allowed to grow over 10 inches. No owner of property shall permit weeds or other noxious vegetation to be on any property within the city limits .
