BACKFLOW TESTING REMINDER FOR UNDERGROUND SPRINKLERS **It is required by both State and Local law to have your backflow assembly tested annually.**

Now is a good time to start thinking about getting an inspection scheduled for your home. If you have a backflow prevention assembly (lawn sprinkler system) on your property, please do your part to ensure a safe drinking water supply for yourself and everyone in Sublimity.
