BACKFLOW TESTING REMINDER FOR UNDERGROUND SPRINKLERS

It is required by both State and Local law to have your backflow assembly tested annually.

Now is a good time to start thinking about getting an inspection scheduled for your home. If you have a backflow prevention assembly (lawn sprinkler system) on your property, please do your part to ensure a safe drinking water supply for yourself and everyone in Sublimity. SAFE SIDEWALKS

A reminder to property owners and or occupants that it is their responsibility to keep sidewalk areas in front of the property clean and clear of debris, dirt, weeds, shrubbery, low branches and safe for the public to use at all times. This also includes weeds in the area in front of the curb. Please do not blow or sweep any debris from driveways or sidewalks into the storm drains or street.

I would like to thank these people that are on Sublimity's new Park Board: Jeff Bohnke, Rick Kauffman, Stacy Hollenbeck, Steve Sedor and Dave Schumacher. They will be advising the Council on matters that pertain to Parks in our community. Currently, the City owns the 2 acre park near the City Hall and it leases the Church park from St. Boniface.

The City received a \$100,000 grant from ODOT called the Small City Allotment Grant. These monies will be used to resurface the streets around the school, NE Pine, SE Pine, and East Main Street.
