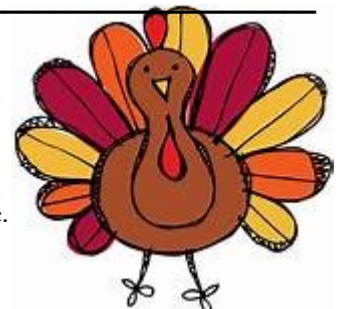
81st Annual Turkey Shoot BINGO:
